## The project is coming to an end!

The ODISSEU project is coming to an end on the 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2021 – the consortium partners would like to thank all those involved in the action in these past three years, who made it possible for us to develop useful educational resources and carry out impactful activities with educators, students, youth and asylum seekers.

During the past few months, ODISSEU partners have been working together to finalise the remaining activities for the project, namely:

- Storytelling workshops for asylum seekers and refugees
- Pilot testing of ODISSEU educational resources with students
- Training sessions for teachers and practitioners
- National Impact Assessment Reports
- Dissemination and Multiplier events in each Country

# ODISSEU Impact Report & Policy Recommendations

As part of the project activities, ODISSEU partners carried out evaluation sessions with and collected feedback from participants to the different activities offered throughout the action. The results have then been compiled and analysed to be included within the ODISSEU Transnational Impact Assessment Report, which comprises an assessment of the impact the project had on beneficiaries (teachers, students, asylum seekers) as well as project partners. Moreover, the report contains information about key strategies and practices related to the themes of ODISSEU, as well as policy recommendations for decision-makers formulated by partners in collaboration with a number of stakeholders. The report will be available by the end of August

### **Multiplier Events**

Between June and July 2021, ODISSEU Partners held Multiplier events at national level, to further disseminate the results of the project with educators, students, asylum seekers, NGOs and

other stakeholders. In some cases, the events served as a base to establish а set of policy recommendations which were then included in the last Transnational Report (see previous section). Overall, the events reached a total of 154 participants from a number of different institutions and backgrounds. The majority of the



events were carried out online due to restrictions still present in most countries, although in some instances this represented an opportunity to widen the project's audiences beyond national reach, and to disseminate the ODISSEU tools and game at European level.
